The 2012 "recommended" criteria per the 2012 AASM scoring manual is referred to in the text as the "3%ODA" criteria 1, 11 The 2007 "Recommended IA" criteria for hypopnea was identical to the 2012 "Acceptable" criteria, and will be referred to by the "4%OD" term to simplify comparisons.
