Key Notes: Clocks Concepts : The dial of the clock is circular in shape and was divided into 60 equal minute spaces. 60 minute spaces traces an angle of 360°. Therefore, 1 minute space traverses an angle of 6°. In 1 hour, Minute hand traverses 60 minute space or 360°, Hour hand traverses 5 minute space or 30°.
